The aim of preparing Cadets Academically, Mentally, and Physically for entry into the National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla, Pune and Armed Forces. It is Residential Military School (English Medium) run by the Shivniketen Trust. The Govt. of Maharashtra has given 30 acres of land at Khadavali (E), Tal.— Kalyan Dist.— Thane. The School Shifted from Kasarvadavali to Khadavali during the Aca. Year 2006-07.

We are preparing the Cadets to join the highly qualified officers cadre in the Indian Armed forces. After the independence , Maharashtra remained to be the backbone of Indian Armed forces. Keeping this great heritage in mind the Maharashtra Govt started an ambitious project of Military Education in Maharashtra. Subsequently the Shivniketan Trust started Bharatiya Sainiki Vidyalaya at Kasarvadavali, G.B.Road, Thane (W) in the year 1998 –99. The school shifted from Kasarvadavali to Khadavali (E), Tal Kalyan Dist Thane in Aca. Year 2006-07 .

Academics: Bharatiya Sainiki Vidyalaya & Jr. College has Classes from VIth to XII(sci.). It is an English Medium school affiliated to the Maharashtra State Board Of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Pune. The XII (Sci.) cadets has to appear twice in the Union Public Service Commission Entrance Examination for entry into National Defence Academy Khadakwasla, Pune. The daily routine of school starts early in the morning at 5.30 AM. and ends at night 22.00PM. This routine consist of tough training like Exercise, Yoga, Physical Training, Horse Riding, Obstacle Courses, Judo, Karate, Taikwondo, Boxing, Rifle Shooting, Mallakhamb, Academic & N.D.A. Periods, Computer & Military Training.

**Boarding and Lodging (House System):** All the cadets from Class VI th to XII (Sci.) resides in the 8 houses. The cadets are distributed equally in all houses. Hostel Superintendent, Retired Military Persons & Hostel Assistant look after the Cadets.



**Messing:** The Trust provides well balanced and nourishing diet to the cadets Separate arrangements exists for Vegetarians and Non-Vegetarians.



**Admission:** Admission for class VI held's in the month of January & June. The exam to be based on subject of Intelligence Test, English, Mathematics and General Knowledge. Candidate has to face Oral, Medical & Physical test followed by written test.. The admission of the candidate is provisional till he cleared all norms of selection procedure. Admission for class VI to IX & XI (sci.) is on the basis of available vacancies following same procedure as above.

**Academic Facilities:** With the tremendous development in the field of education and educational infrastructure, Bharatiya Sainiki Vidyalaya & Jr. College has developed own infrastructure for academic and non academic pursuits of students. Some of the highlights are as follows.

#### ARYA WANGMAY MARATHI FORUM




#### KALIDAS HINDI SAHITYA FORUM


#### 1. Co-relation Between Barometric Pressure and wind Velocity.
